A bitter sweet comedy follows a womanizing former political leader who is stepped down from his position after years of service to his unnamed country. With just two last days left to enjoy his extravagant government villa before he is finally evicted, his situation gradually goes from bad to worse. The film is not just about the leaving of one politician from his office, but more generally about the phenomenon of change itself: every second something done and something irretrievably goes. We do not know from where everything emerges and know even less to where it disappears. This is in fact a classic theme of dramas: the end. The end of a man. The end of an era. The end of a community. The end of love.

The film Leaving is first directorial film effort of Václav Havel former president of the Czech Republic. He has received many national awards, international awards and honorary doctorates

for his literary works, for his opinions, and for his lifelong efforts on the observance of human rights.

Sylvia, the protagonist of the story, marries Hynek, a young doctor. He is an only child, and at the age of thirty five still mummy's darling, tied to her by a strong emotional bond. Alžběta (Elisabeth), as Hynek's mother is called, has chained him to herself by pathological parental love, and it is unthinkable for her that she should share her son with his wife. At the same time, she starts realizing that once Hynek gets married, he will move out and she will remain alone. Therefore she tries to thwart the young couple's wedding plans, using all means fair and foul. And when she fails, she tries to wreck their marriage, never tiring of seeking pretexts for causing a conflict with Sylvia. Following several abortive attempts, she succeeds at last in bringing about the breakdown of the marriage - through Valerie, a domestic help, whom she plants in the newly-weds' household. Valerie quickly installs herself and starts

pursuing her own interests. The complaisant Hynek soon finds himself in the role of table-tennis ball. His mother has opened a shrewd game - which is however gradually slipping from her control. In the end, it's her who pays the highest price for her own scheming.

A post-apocalyptic science fiction. A total collapse of the civilized world leaves a part of Europe inhabitable. Small groups of people survive in safe zones which are separated from one another by belts of land where military technology, which has got entirely out of control, is creating lethal „traps“. Only the „runners“ are able to cross the dangerous territories. The fate of several people who have decided to find a safe place for a new life depends on one such runner. The film is a post-apocalyptic science fiction the atmosphere of which is extraordinarily suggestive. It authentically expresses the fears and hopes of today's inhabitants of Central Europe, and outlines the possible (and relatively probable) consequences of the present-time civilization and political development of society - things which we suspect could happen, and which loom at the back of our minds as a vague threat.

A man unjustly sentenced twenty years ago to life imprisonment for murder is suffering behind bars while the real murderer, member of the smart set, is living in the glare of popularity and public recognition. Ellis, a Czecho-American, visits the seriously ill prisoner, with the intention to obtain presidential pardon for him. During her visit she learns the truth about the murder, committed at the time of the totalitarian regime. Apart from suspense and surprising twists, the story offers a gripping retrospective glance of the atmosphere in Prague of the 1980s, prior to the Velvet Revolution, when goods of practically all sorts were in short supply, and as the Czech currency was inconvertible, illicit money-changing thrived. University student Peter Liška becomes one of the links in the chain of fraudsters and wheeler-dealers. As a result, he lacks neither pals nor money, and indulges in all life's delights

to his heart's content. Everything is fine – until Peter finds his accomplice and best friend Paul in a pool of blood. Frightened that the police might arrest him as a suspect, he decides to go it alone and track the murderer down himself.

Television film in three parts, about a serious problem of our current reality – the clients of children's homes about to reach adulthood and enter normal life for which they are little prepared, often finding that coping with it is painful. It is this complicated stage through which the siblings Marie, Adam and Eva are passing. The dramatic ways in which they do so vary, and yet they have much in common. Twenty-two-year old Marie is completing her training as a social worker, Adam, aged eighteen, is leaving the children's home, while for the seventeen-year old Eva, this crucial moment still is to come. This is the trio of the protagonists whom we meet at the beginning of the story. They are tied by blood relation, and have the same mother, unable to cope with her motherhood. They have the habits and experience typical of clients of children's homes, and lack those which are regarded in the outside environment as natural and taken for granted – for

instance the routines of a "normal" family. Their bond is extraordinarily strong, but now and then the three of them confront a world which is unfamiliar, rough and unforgiving. They must not only accept it outwardly, but above grasp it inwardly, in order to compare favourably with those who are not thus handicapped.

The latest news: in March 2011, a surgical team, led by MUDr. Bohdan Pomahač, in a Boston hospital performed a full face transplant on a Dallas Wiens who was badly disfigured in a power line accident and was blind and without lips, nose or eyebrows. The patient's sight couldn't be recovered but he has been able to talk on the phone and smell.

The film director was especially interested in its socially educational aspect. The dancers were children aged 8 – 18 chosen at schools in “problem” quarters. The project Špalíček to music by Bohuslav Martinů was based on the incentive of the successful artistic project of the Berlin Philharmonic Orchestra. The aim of the Czech project was the participation of children and young people into the process who had as yet had no experience nor any special dispositions for dance or other forms of artistic expression and came from different social and national groups, in combination with children talented for dancing.

Recording of the 500th concert of the International Music Festival "Smetana's Litomyšl" (taking place in the composer's native town), for which the violin virtuoso Pavel Šporcl "teamed up" with the Slovak Romany cimbalom band Romano Stilo. It was not only the meeting of representatives of different music types, but also the unusual repertoire and the atmosphere on the platform and in the auditorium that made the event unique. Just as Pavel Šporcl crosses with gusto the borders between the classical and other music genres, Romano Stilo can hardly be regarded as an "orthodox" cimbalom band. Melodies of Slovak, Hungarian, Romanian and mainly Romany folk songs were blended in the concert programme with original arrangements of famous pieces of classical music. Šporcl plays repertoire which may seem to be the preserve of musicians with gypsy blood in their veins with

absolute confidence, his rendering is convincing, and in Romano Stilo he found excellent partners.
