SYNOPSIS

Bob & Bobby the rabbits live in a caravan that belonged to a famous conjurer, in an allotment garden, where they are all preparing for this year's "Golden Root" vegetable show. Bob and Bobby want to win, but they're not very good at gardening. Rabbit's neighbour, Mr. Smarty, also wants to win and so he uses banned chemicals in his garden. He takes the empty chemical barrels into the woods where he illegally dumps them, poisoning the food of the local rabbits. The rabbits then steal food from the allotment garden. Smarty tells Bob and Bobby that their vegetables are being taken by the dreaded Carrot Eater. When the rabbits set on the trail of Carrot Eater and try to catch him, they discover the hares and use magic to help them clean up their forest.











BOB & BOBSY live in a hat in a caravan that belonged to a famous conjurer which is full of magic props, but whenever one of them tries to use one it always somehow blows up in their face... (The conjurer hasn't turned up for several years. His trick of

disappearing in front of his wife was so successful that his wife is still travelling around the world to look for him) The caravan is located on an allotment, near to a medium-sized town. **BOB** – is bigger, smarter, and often takes on the role of the parent. He endeavours to always do the best he can in everything, even if it doesn't always go according to plan, as is often the case for parents. **BOBBY** – is smaller, but resourceful and imaginative, and often takes on the role of the child. Both rabbits have novel ideas which often get them into trouble, leading to comical situations.



MR. SMARTY

has a garden right next to Bob and Bobby which he has looked after for many years. Smarty loves competing, especially when he wins. This means he has won loads of prizes from best vegetable competitions. In order to win, he secretly uses pesticides, herbicides, poisons, fertilizers and other chemicals which he feeds to his vegetables, so they are the most impressive far and wide.
