One of the first operations he takes part in however turns into a tragedy, when his father dies under the wheels of a pursued car. Still Roman stays in the employ of the police, no longer the traffic but the criminal investigation department, becoming the cameraman of its elite unit.

Despite a far-from-easy start, he gradually "settles" into the team, mainly thanks to an attractive female colleague. Nevertheless, it is obvious that he will have a problem complying with the established rules: he prefers doing things his way. Including the investigation of his fathers murder.

He learns to live among circus artistes, has a platonic romance with acrobat Silvia, resists pressures exerted on him by the circus owner - all the time dodging the stubborn detective Kuneš who is after him. And how did it all start? With the seeming suicide of his student and mistress rolled into one. Nestor becomes suspect number one, and decides to search for the real culprit "off his own bat". But then further murders happen... The original, suspenseful plot with a markedly noirish tinge is full of twists and surprises.
